“The words that I have spoken to you are spirit, and are life.”
(John 6:63b - NASB)

LOVE. We rejoice in the Good News that God loves us all! This love transcends race, gender, social status, even religion. The features will help us follow more closely the readings for each day, as the specific verses are indicated. Included are also the Responses to the Psalm of the Mass, so that our reflection of all the readings are deeper and more complete.

For Sundays and Solemnities, the format is as follows:

Line 1 - Date, Day and Sunday or Solemnity
Line 2 - 1st Reading / Responsorial Psalm / 2nd Reading / Gospel
Line 3 - Response to the Psalm

**The readings are separated by a slash*

Example:

3 SN 1st SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Is 63:16b-17, 19b; 64:2-7 / Ps 80:2-3, 15-16, 18-19 /
1 Cor 1:3-9 / Mk 13:33-37

Lord, make us turn to you; let us see your face and we shall be saved.

For Ferial days/Weekdays:

Line 1 - Date, Day, 1st Reading / Responsorial Psalm / Gospel Reading
Line 2 - Response to the Psalm

**The readings are separated by a slash*

Example:

4 M Is 2:1-5 / Ps 122:1-2, 3-4b, 4cd-5, 6-7, 8-9 / Mt 8:5-11
Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

We have also included a directory of the abbreviations of the Books in the Bible and the guide for the Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer.
